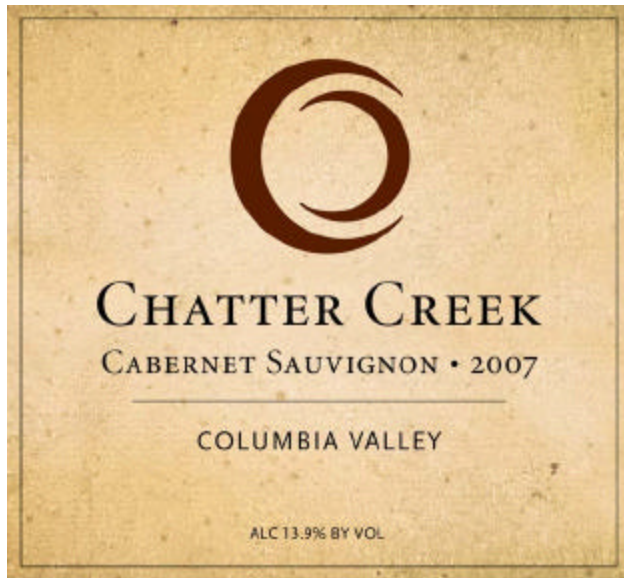


# Cabernet Sauvignon

The 2007 vintage was a classic warm year for Washington. The effect was centered fruit and berry flavors, with smooth tannins, resulting in very balanced and inviting wines with a robustness found in warm Washington vintages.

This wine shows dark purple with some ruby on the rim. The bright nose is intertwined with a complex mix of blueberry and black cherry, with hints of coffee, and blackberry elements. A medley of flavors, including blueberry, cassis and cedar, lingers in a tremendously round mid-palette. Creamy and rich, with a good mouth feel, it is a medium to full-bodied wine, well-balanced and even, with smooth tannins. A lingering finish leaves you both satisfied and ready for more.
